What is a vision statement?

Think of it as answering the question: "Where do we want to go?" It's meant to be ambitious, motivating, and forward-thinking.

Guiding criteria:

- Makes clear what is unique to the subject
- Reflects the key drivers in the context of that subject
- Is focussed on the essence of the subject
- Future focussed

Vision statement

Visual Arts and Design is a holistic discipline that fosters students to become confident and creative individuals. Through artistic practice, students will be empowered to navigate creative risks alongside personal growth. Students will use Art and Design as a vehicle for self-expression, meaningful communication, and to build a richer understanding of the human experience.
