## Switching between English and Japanese language in e-exams and device set-up

The Japanese (continuers) e-exam requires responses to be provided in English and Japanese. It is important that language keyboard packs are downloaded and enabled prior to the e-exam and students are familiar with using the language keyboards on the device they will be using during the examination.

- Steps: Setting > Time & Language > Language > Japanese > Options > Microsoft
  IME > Options > General > 'Use Kana input for hardware keyboard' > 'Off'
- Ensure students turn the predictive input settings 'On'.
