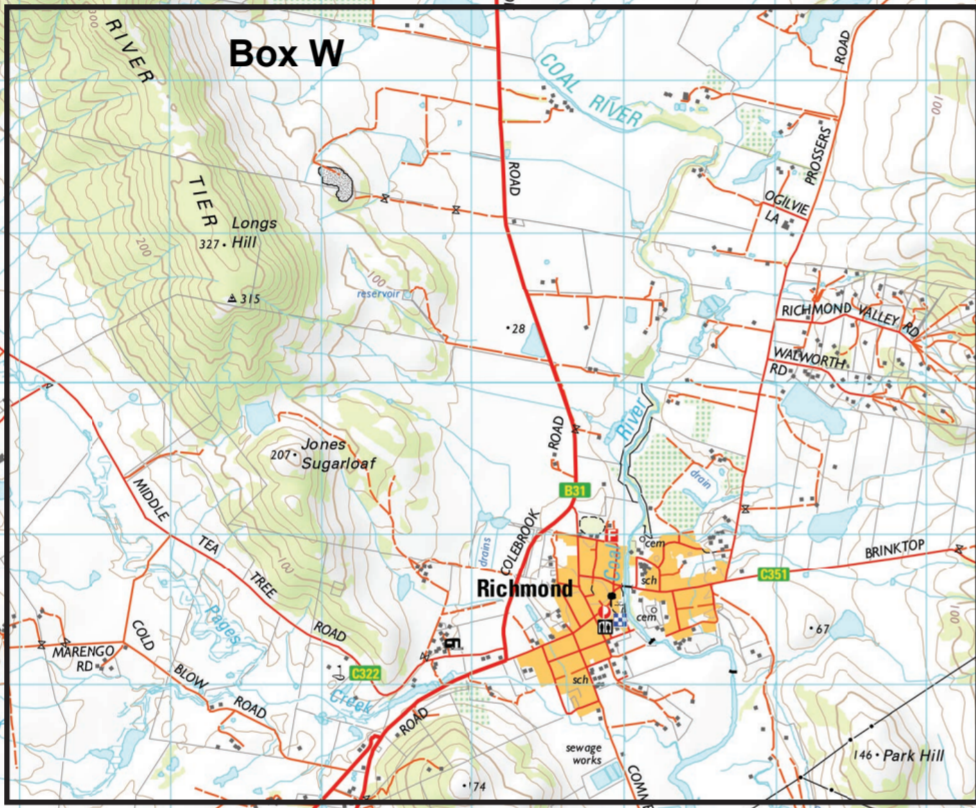
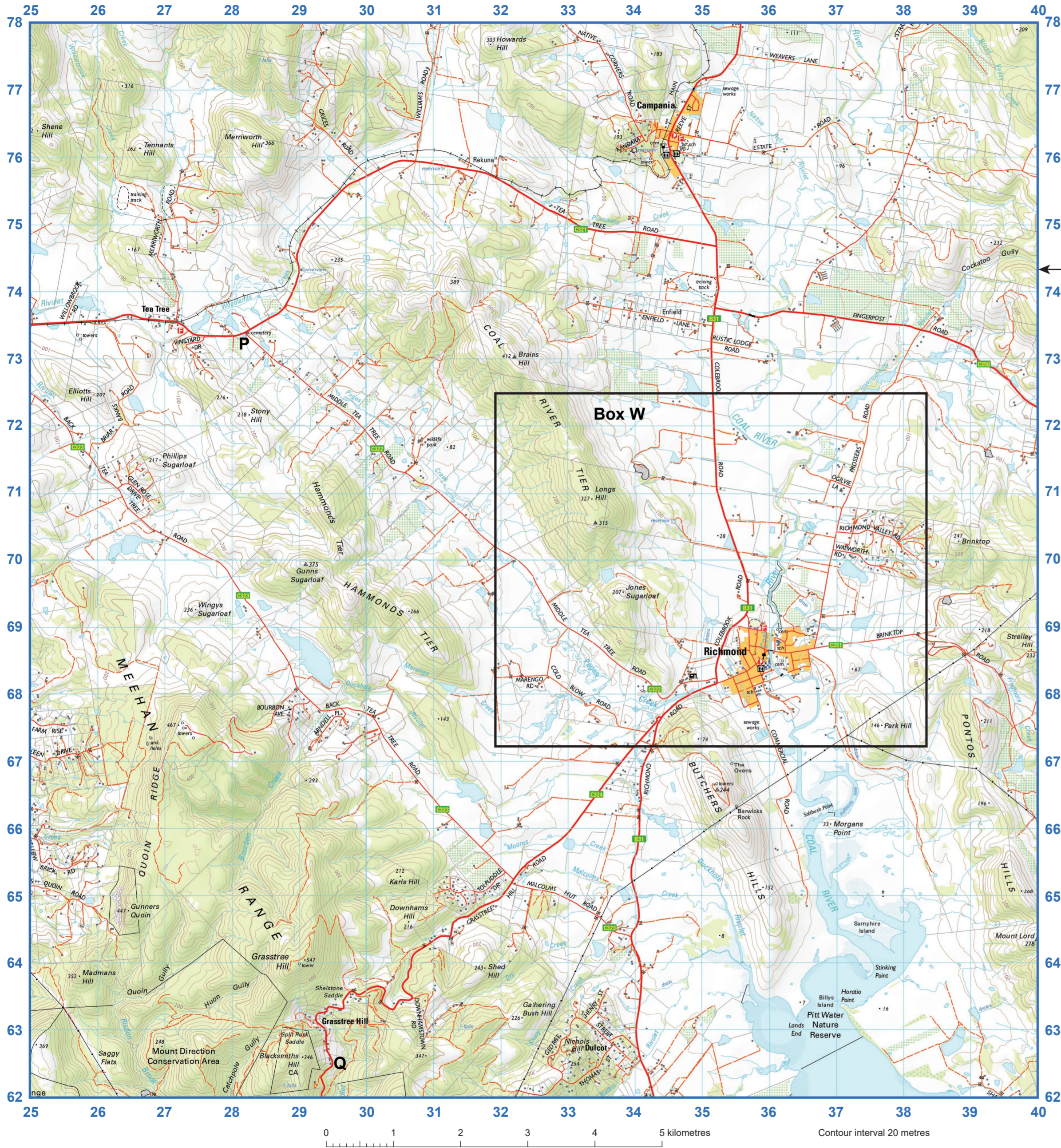

COAL RIVER, Scale 1:50 000

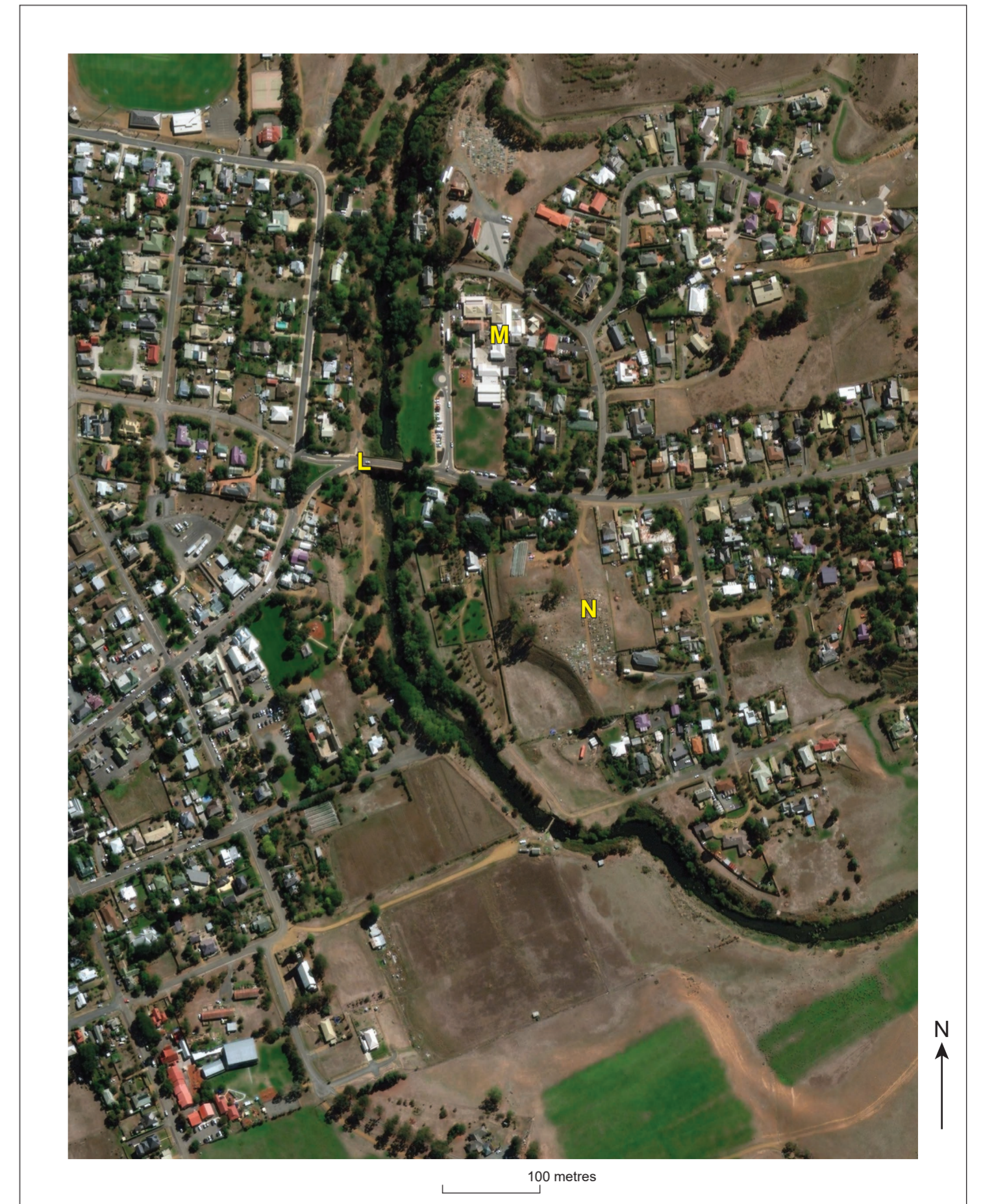


Location of COAL RIVER map, Tasmania
