

### VET Recognition Register: Hospitality Qualifications



The VET Recognition Register is a key tool in the recognition arrangements for VET and is a list posted on the SACE Board website so that schools and the public:

- can identify whether the SACE credits granted for completed VET will be recognised towards Stage 1 or Stage 2 of the SACE.
- can get an indication of how many SACE credits may be granted for the completion of a particular VET qualification.

This information should be read in conjunction with the VET Recognition Register - Information Sheet.

#### Shaded and non-shaded qualifications

For qualifications listed that are *non-shaded*, recognition panels recommended that, in their view, these qualifications may provide pathways for young people if commenced within a secondary schooling context.

For *shaded* qualifications as indicated by the following icon - (!) school students and schools are advised to take into account a range of factors that may influence the pathways in the industry area before selecting one of these questions.

Factors could include age-appropriate aspects, any award or industrial implications, and whether the qualification leads to a future pathway or employment opportunities. Factors that apply to one qualification may not necessarily apply to other qualifications.

Things to remember as indicated by the following icon -

- Actual credits granted to the student is dependent on the units of competency completed by the student toward the qualification. The SACE credits range column is based on the range of nominal hours for successful completion of the qualification, as outlined in the Training Package's Implementation and/or Purchasing Guide. The maximum number of SACE credits listed is the maximum number of SACE credits that will be awarded to students for that particular VET qualification.
- The Traineeship and Apprenticeship Pathways Schedule (TAPS) provides a consolidated list of occupations that have been declared under the Training and Skills Development Act 2008 as trades (apprenticeships) or declared vocations (traineeships) in SA. The schedule also identifies qualifications that can be undertaken in conjunction with these apprenticeships and traineeships, and these are indicated with a tick.

#### Hybrid Qualifications Information

For qualifications that are identified as 'Hybrid (Stage 1 and 2)', refer to the <u>Hybrid Qualifications - Information Sheet</u>. Hybrid Qualifications - Information Sheet details the recognition arrangement for hybrid qualifications, including the units of competencies at each SACE Stage.
